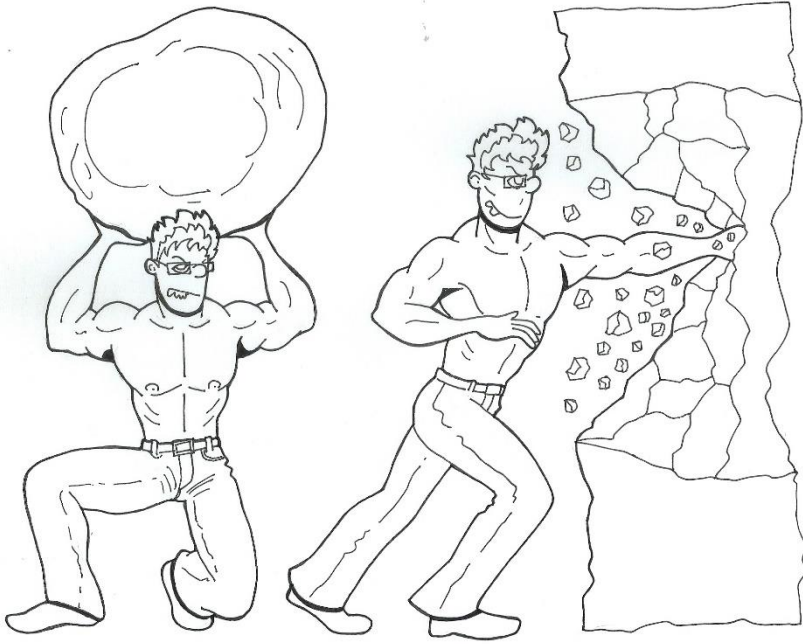


# Omar's Falcon Book 2

The Dag is He



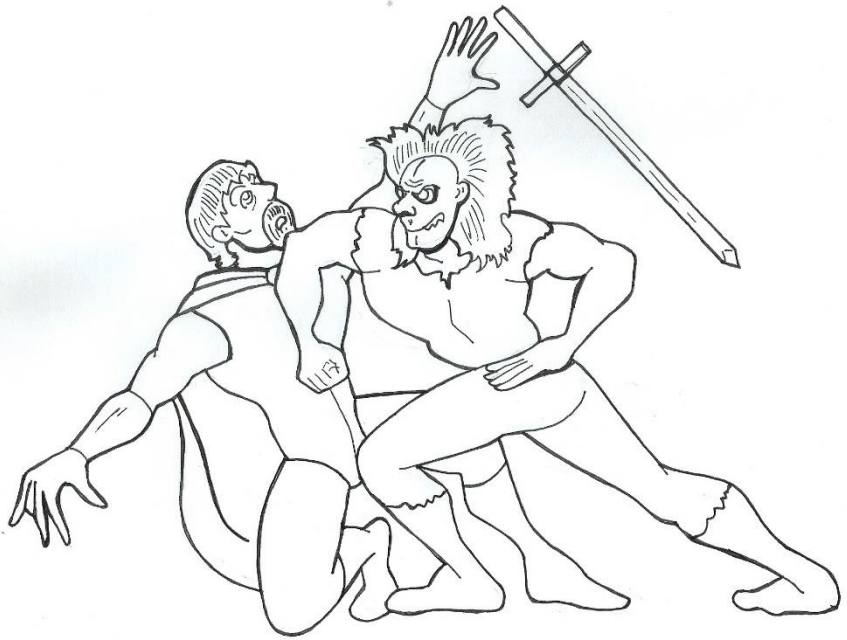
